Rongzom's Kurukulle Drubchö
H.E. Lhalung Sungtrül Rinpoche

What is Kurukulle Drubchö?

Drubchö means «Great Accomplishment» and is an elaborate form of Vajrayana buddhist practice over 3 to 8 days. This intensive practice retreat is focused around the activation of a central mandala that contains objects and substances that are empowered during the ritual. It is similar to a Drubchen but is not practiced 24 hours a day. We will receive an empowerment of Rongzom's Kurukulle and then perform intensive practice of Kurukulle, led by H.E. Lhalung Sungtrül Rinpoche and his lamas. In the end we will receive the blessings of the substances and objects of the Mandala.

Kurukulle is a dakini from the lotus family, which is associated with the activity of magnetizing or enchantment. She is usually depicted in red, in dancing posture and with a flowery bow and arrow. She is also one of the twenty-one Taras mentioned in the Root Tara Tantras.

Through her activity of attracting and controlling relative, worldly things (ordinary Siddhis) wealth, auspicious circumstances, a consort etc. can be magnetized.

However, the ultimate benefit of the Kurukulle practice is the attainment of the highest, extraordinary siddhis, which is equivalent to enlightenment.

At present we are ignorant and under the influence of external circumstances. Ultimately, through Kurukulle practice (Mantra, Mudra and Samadhi) together with a deep understanding of the law of dependent origination circumstances, situations as well as the necessary instructions are attracted that promote the path to enlightenment. Through practice, combined with the primordial wisdom of this Lotus Dakini, direct influence is exerted on our mind, bringing all external phenomena, the animate and inanimate universe, under our control.
